The poem was without a title when Shelley passed it along to his contemporary and friend, Thomas Love Peacock. The poem is 720 lines long. It is considered to be one of the first of Shelley's major poems. Peacock suggested the name Alastor which comes from Roman mythology. Peacock has defined Alastor as evil genius. The name does not refer to the hero or Poet of the poem, however, but instead to the spirit who divinely animates the Poet's imagination. In Alastor the speaker ostensibly recounts the life of a Poet who zealously pursues the most obscure part of nature in search of strange truths in undiscovered lands, journeying to the Caucasus Mountains (the ethereal cliffs of Caucasus), Persia, Arabia, Cashmere, and the wild Carmanian waste. The Poet rejects an Arab maiden in his search for an idealised embodiment of a woman. As the Poet wanders...
