Our heroine cracks jokes about Victorian constructions of femininity (Why is an unbound book like a young maiden in bed?), explores her self-perception (i don t know why/ i am always wanting you / someone to have my interiority), tells bald-faced lies, has plenty of sex and continually distracts herself and whoever might try to cut her down to size: If you are still confused/ by the form, invoke/ its creator, its secret/ prey. Jolly with/ composition, she/ has stretched/ her lower lip/ up over her head.
